## KENYA MISSION RESCUE

Our church supports a group of young girls from the Maasai tribe in Kenya. The laws in Kenya make female circumcision illegal, but the Maasai tribe continues to practice this and to marry girls off as young as 8 years old. We are involved in rescuing girls from 2 local villages and putting them in school with boarding. Cost is approximately \$35 per month with approximately \$15 per month for books, school supplies, hygiene products, and uniforms that need to be replaced every other year. In November when the schools let out, we help pay for a safe house for the girls to stay in until school resumes in January. If you are able to help support the girls monthly or would like to make an occasional donation, please fill out an envelope with your name, amount, frequency and write Mission Rescue on the envelope. 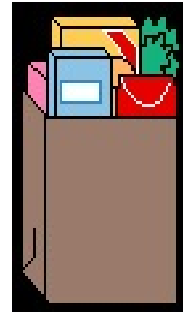

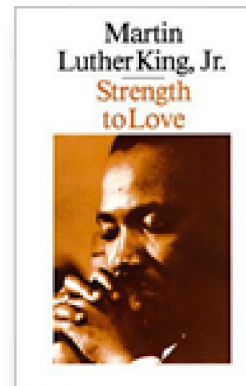
## GLEANERS/KROGER FOOD DRIVE
